- TN General Assembly - 2nd Tuesday in January
- Pickett County Offices - September 1
- Byrdstown Offices - September 1

Note regarding county primaries for Pickett County: historically, Republicans have held a primary, while Democrats have held a caucus. This may change for future election cycles.

The above list does not include State judges, referendums, contests to fill vacancies, or special elections.

Byrdstown city offices and School Board offices are nonpartisan positions.
